

Techspire Top 100 Scholarship Program – Terms and Conditions

By applying for or accepting a scholarship through the Techspire Top 100 Scholarship Program, applicants agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. Eligibility

- Applicants must have completed their 12th grade or equivalent and meet the academic, financial, and geographic eligibility requirements outlined in the scholarship criteria.
- Only students planning to pursue further education in a recognized academic institution are eligible.

2. Scholarship Awards

- Scholarships are categorized as follows:
 - 10 Full Scholarships (covering all academic expenses)
 - 20 x 100% College Tuition Scholarships
 - 30 x 50% College Tuition Scholarships
 - 40 x 40% College Tuition Scholarships
- The type and amount of scholarship awarded is determined solely by Techspire based on the applicant's score and evaluation.

3. Selection Criteria

- Selection is based on a point-based evaluation of the following:
 - Academic performance (GPA)
 - Entrance examination results
 - Type of school attended
 - Financial condition
 - Geographic background
 - Personal interview performance
- Final selection is at the discretion of the Techspire Scholarship Committee.

4. Entrance Examination

- All applicants must participate in the scheduled scholarship examination.
- The examination format includes objective, descriptive, and free-writing components.
- Exam dates are fixed (August 17, 24, and 31, 2025) and are non-negotiable.

5. Interview

- Shortlisted candidates will be required to attend an interview either in person or virtually.
- Interview performance may affect final scholarship placement.

6. Accuracy of Information

- Applicants must provide accurate and complete information. Submission of false documents or misrepresentation will result in disqualification and revocation of any awarded scholarship.

7. Non-transferability

- Scholarships are awarded to individuals and are non-transferable.
- The scholarship amount is not redeemable for cash and cannot be exchanged for other benefits.

8. Documentation

- Applicants may be asked to submit financial documents, academic transcripts, and identity verification.
- Failure to provide necessary documentation may result in disqualification.

9. Revocation

- Techspire reserves the right to withdraw or cancel any scholarship if:
 - The recipient fails to enroll or continue in an eligible program.
 - Misconduct or violation of academic or behavioral policies occurs.
 - Fraudulent information is discovered.

10. Privacy and Use of Data

- Applicant data will be used solely for scholarship processing and program improvement.
- Personal data will be handled in accordance with applicable data protection laws.
